

# Through Partner Agency Programs:

## EDUCATION

- \$15** helps Boy Scouts register one boy into the scouting program for one year
- \$10** a week for one year will train 24 volunteers, who can lead 12 Girl Scout troops
- \$200** will purchase adaptive equipment to help children at Bona Vista without verbal skills communicate with others
- \$100** trains 16 volunteers to operate a Red Cross shelter
- \$52** pays for the assessment tests used by the Literacy Coalition for someone new entering the program

## HEALTH

- \$154** pays for food, shelter, case management and therapy for one person, one day in the Family Service Association domestic violence shelter
- \$20** will provide one child a membership at Carver Community Center for one year
- \$5** per week will pay for a Visiting Nurse Service homecare visit to a low income client
- \$10** provides one hour of case management at the Mental Health Association
- \$50** provides a CASA volunteer with the initial 32 hours of training to be a voice for a child in court

## INCOME

- \$1** provides a client with **\$15** of food through The Salvation Army
- It costs Samaritan Caregivers **\$100** to supply rides to recipients for a three hour period
- \$25** provides **\$140** worth of diabetes supplies including testing strips, testing meter and meal planning through Project Access
- \$50** a month pays for hundreds of teens to access the internet for homework at the YMCA
- \$120** feeds a family of four for a month at Food Finder's Food Bank. This cost would be **\$960** retail.
